A handsome wooden book-wall frames the archway that leads from the lounge to the linear kitchen of the Alfred Street Residence. This, combined with the raised flooring, draws a clear line between the very different functions that the two rooms serve. The kitchen's snow-white walls and units draw the eye to the elongated dining table, which becomes a workspace and breakfast bar at the far end. Tall pivot doors keep a butler's pantry and laundry hidden but also easily accessible. A section of the sidewall is fitted with ceiling-height windows that open onto the patio.
